What a week it has been! Firstly thank you to all the children for their wonderful Christmas productions this week. We were all so proud of their performances; they really did themselves and the school proud.




We would also like to thank all the amazing parents and helpers who came into school to help Year 2 with their sewing. Your help and patience was definitely appreciated!

Santa Challenge


