

School Vision



As a Church School, our School Vision is rooted in a Bible verse. The verse that has been chosen for our school is, "Let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven." Matthew 5:16.

Our Motto (Belief Statement) 'Where We All Shine' comes directly from this verse and you will see it emblazoned on our school uniform and in all correspondence.

At the start of the school year, you will remember that pupils were given a St. Augustine's Box containing the eight items representing the elements of our school vision. These underpin all that we hold dear at St. Augustine's Academy.

'The St. Augustine's Way', highlights our Golden Rules: Show Respect, Be Kind and Try Our Best, and also indicates the Values which we aim to live by.
