It has been a big week for our Early Years. We are coming to the end of the 'Hello' Project which has focused the school on the improvement and development of communication skills in our youngest pupils.

In order to do this we put in place a range of new techniques and initiatives, during the past two terms, and are delighted with the progress that our pupils have made.

Some of the things that have worked particularly well are the Stay and Play sessions which enable parents to come and join in with the learning in Early Years and gain ideas

for activities that they could use at home: the introduction of a Board Game library and a Book Library for parents so that they can freely choose books with their children.




We have also worked at developing our classroom
