The three values that came out top in our survey, and which will now form the basis of our Behaviour Policy, were the following:

Show Respect Be Kind Try Your Best

We believe these values make a great trio and convey the school's expectations very clearly. We have also developed a Behaviour Chart which visibly sets out rewards for pupils displaying these values, and sanctions for pupils not keeping them. Our Behaviour Chart is attached to this newsletter; if you have any views about it, we would love to hear them before we formally roll it out to pupils, after the half term holiday.

This week, we also held our half termly Parent Forum. We talked about the progress of the school during the last term; our foci for the term ahead and behaviour. Thank you to everyone who came to the meeting and contributed thoughts and ideas; it was extremely valuable to hear your feedback.



Also, last Friday, Year 3 enjoyed a Roman Day at St Albans Abbey where they learnt about everyday life in Roman times, including dressing up in Roman costume

and learning about Roman food and cookery. They had a wonderful time and did some excellent learning.
