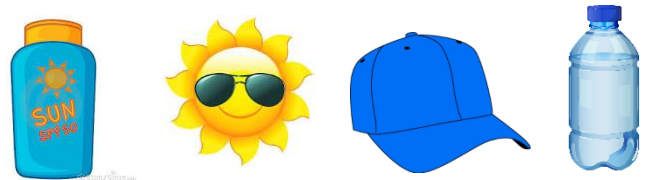
Value of the Half Term
